In 1964, the Kennedy Half Dollar was first struck on a 90% silver planchet. In 1965, this was changed to a 40% silver clad planchet and was struck through 1970. During the earliest days at the U.S. Mint, from 1792 through 1836, the Mint did not have any reduction lathes to transfer the coin's design from a galvano to a master hub.
